

Texas Wesleyan University Admissions - SMS Terms and Conditions

This document provides the terms and conditions regarding SMS messaging communications from the Office of Admissions at Texas Wesleyan University.

The Office of Admissions sends text messages using a SMS messaging service to communicate with students about application and enrollment deadlines, application updates, event notifications and reminders, and other important information about the admissions process. Messages may also be sent to parents/guardians of the students. Subscribing to this service is not required to apply for or gain admission to the university. This service provides you with information via text messaging the university deems helpful and pertinent to the admission process.

Opt-in

Prospective students may opt-in to receive text messages (i.e., SMS messages) by completing an [information request form](#) or creating an account on the TXWES admissions portal at <http://apply.txwes.edu/>. Students may also opt-in by updating their communication preferences on their [TXWES admissions portal](#). Consent to receive SMS messages is optional and not a condition of applying, enrolling, or participating in the admissions process.

Messaging Costs

Standard message and data rates from your wireless carrier may apply. When you opt-in to receive SMS messages, you are responsible for any carrier fees such as data plan charges, text messaging charges, tolls, out-of-area roaming, and other charges. Messaging frequency per month varies based on your student status and associated actions. Check with your mobile operator for details on receiving text messages (SMS).

Carriers

Note that SMS communications from the Office of Admissions may not be available through all mobile carriers.

STOP/Opt-out Information

If you wish to opt-out of text messages, text STOP to stop receiving text messages from the admissions office. You can text HELP for help. You may also update your preferences in your [TXWES admissions portal](#). Please note that opting out will remove

you from all future text communications with the admissions office, including events you may register for in the future or application updates, unless you are able to re-subscribe to such services.

Admissions SMS Privacy Disclosure

Texas Wesleyan University will not ask you for, nor should you provide, personally identifiable information, passwords, or any other confidential or sensitive information in SMS messages. Except as permitted by the university's policies, the Office of Admissions does not share your information with third parties.

Mobile phone numbers and SMS opt-in consent are collected from the Office of Admissions solely for the purpose of delivering the text messages described at the time of opt-in. SMS opt-in data and consent will not be sold, rented, shared, transferred, or disclosed by the Office of Admissions to any third parties or affiliates for marketing or promotional purposes.

The Office of Admissions does not share text messaging originator opt-in data or consent with any third parties, except with trusted service providers that assist us in delivering SMS communications (such as messaging platform providers), and only for the purpose of facilitating message delivery and related support services.

Other offices, departments, or organizations at the university may collect and use information in forms different than described herein, and as such, you should review the university's policies, and the policies of any other electronic services or website that you may use.
