YuJa Viewing Tips

- You must press Play to see viewing options and controls.
- Videos have an index. Look for the bright blue divider that says "Contents" to search for key terms or to view specific video segments.
- At the bottom-right of the video player, you will find four buttons: show closed captioning, show sidebar, toggle full screen, and other settings.
 - Pro-tip: Click the settings icon (the gear) to see a host of controls, including one called Speed. You can play the video back at a higher (or lower) speed!
 - Expand the sidebar or scroll below the video to download Dennis Hall's presentation slides on Gen Z students.
