Pre-Counseling

Students interested in counseling as a career path are well served at Texas Wesleyan University. Classes within the <u>psychology degree</u> and sociology programs help provide students with an understanding of counseling and therapy.

Pursuing a <u>psychology degree</u> prepares students for entry into graduate programs offering Master's degrees in different areas of counseling. Students should maintain a GPA above 3.0 to increase their likelihood of admission success. Applicants are required to take the Graduate Record Exam (GRE).

Admission Requirements for Texas Wesleyan University Masters in Counseling

- Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university with at least 9 hours in <u>psychology</u>, counseling or related coursework, including at least one statistics and one human development course.
- One of the following requirements
 - 1. 3.0 cumulative GPA score or 3.25 over the last 60 hours
 - 2. An official GRE score report. Recommended achievement of 150 verbal, 142 quantitative and 4.0 writing.
 - 3. Mental health casework and/or field experience with minimum GPA of 2.5 cumulative
- Interview session with program faculty
