## **Correct Word Usage Tips**

Some simple tips and tricks can help you clean up word usage and improve your paper's clarity.

Where to start:

- Never use a word that you don't fully understand.
  Instead, use words common to your personal vocabulary.
- Read your paper aloud in order to catch mistakes.
  The average double-spaced paper takes 2 minutes to read aloud.
  Reading aloud can also uncover sentence structure and grammatical errors.
- ✓ Ask a friend or fellow student to read your paper. Often times, we miss our own mistakes. A second set of eyes can often catch oversights.
- ✓ Stop by the Academic Success Center and ask for a "proof-reading" session. Our tutors are always ready to assist in any area of writing.

When in doubt, consult a dictionary.

- ✓ Check your understanding of the word.
  Never build your vocabulary using a thesaurus.
- ✓ Dictionaries include several possible definitions of a given word. Make sure you fully understand the word before you use it.
- ✓ Synonyms and antonyms are often provided.
  Double-check these suggestions before you use them!
