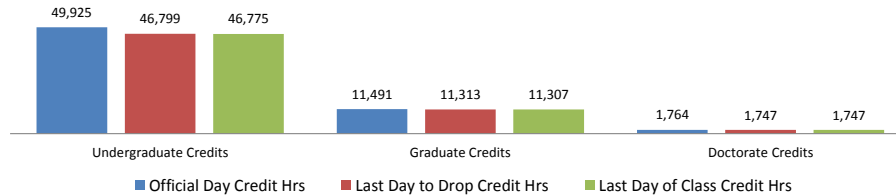

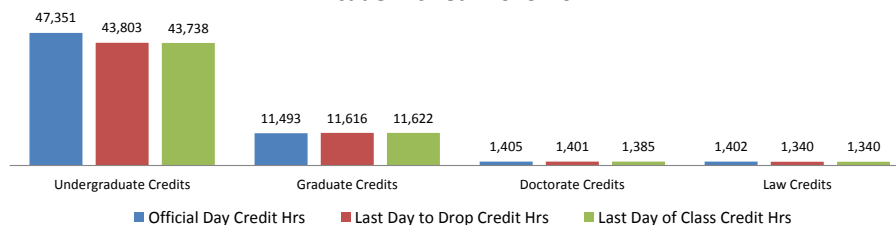
Academic Year 2015-2016

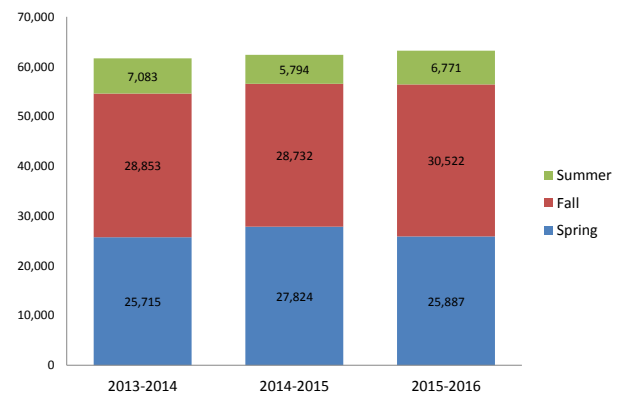
Graduate Credit Hours



Doctoral Credit Hours



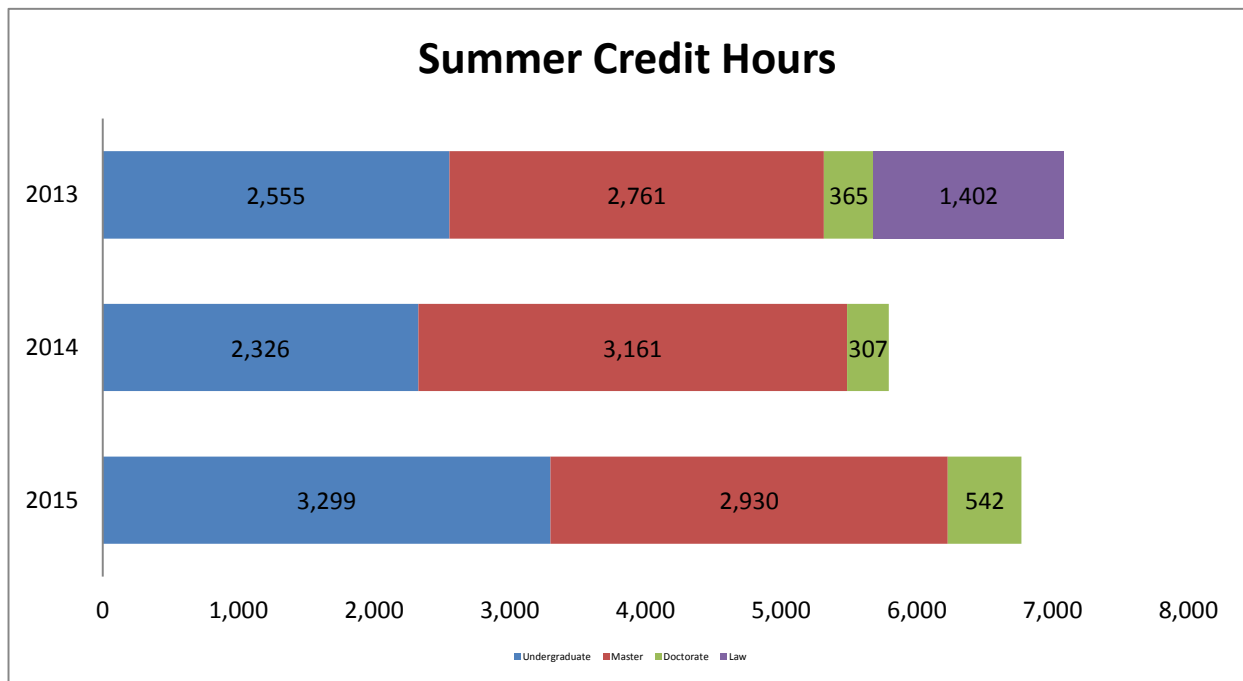

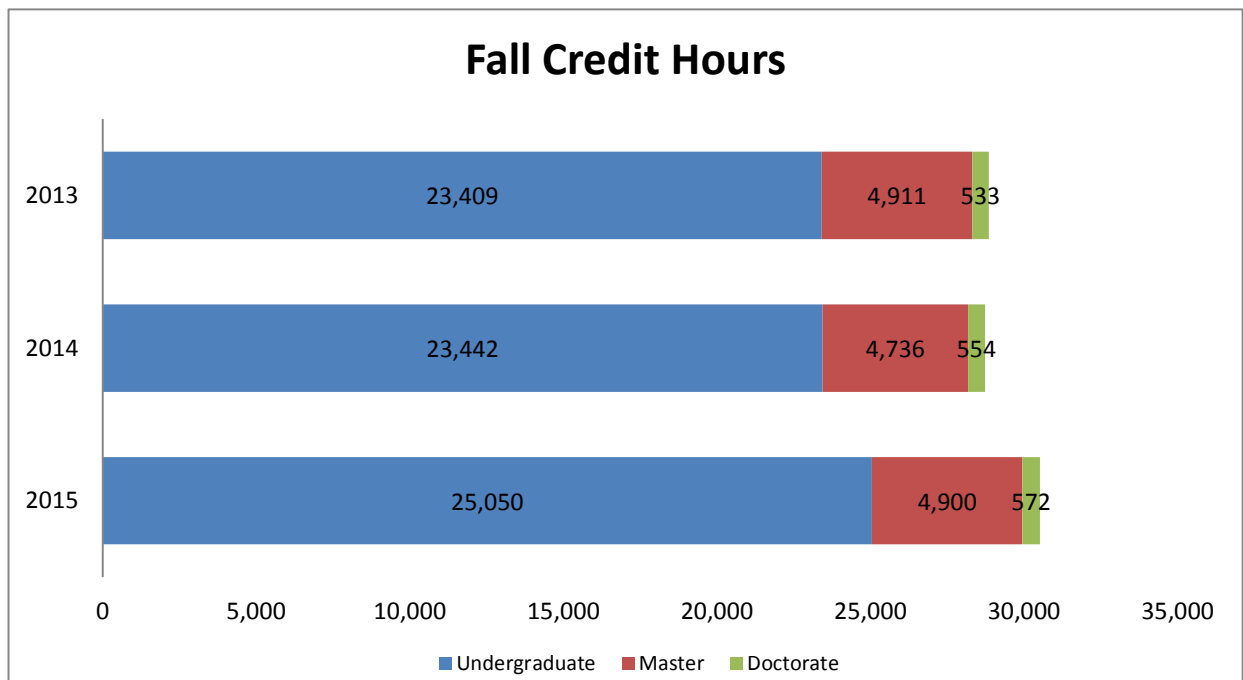

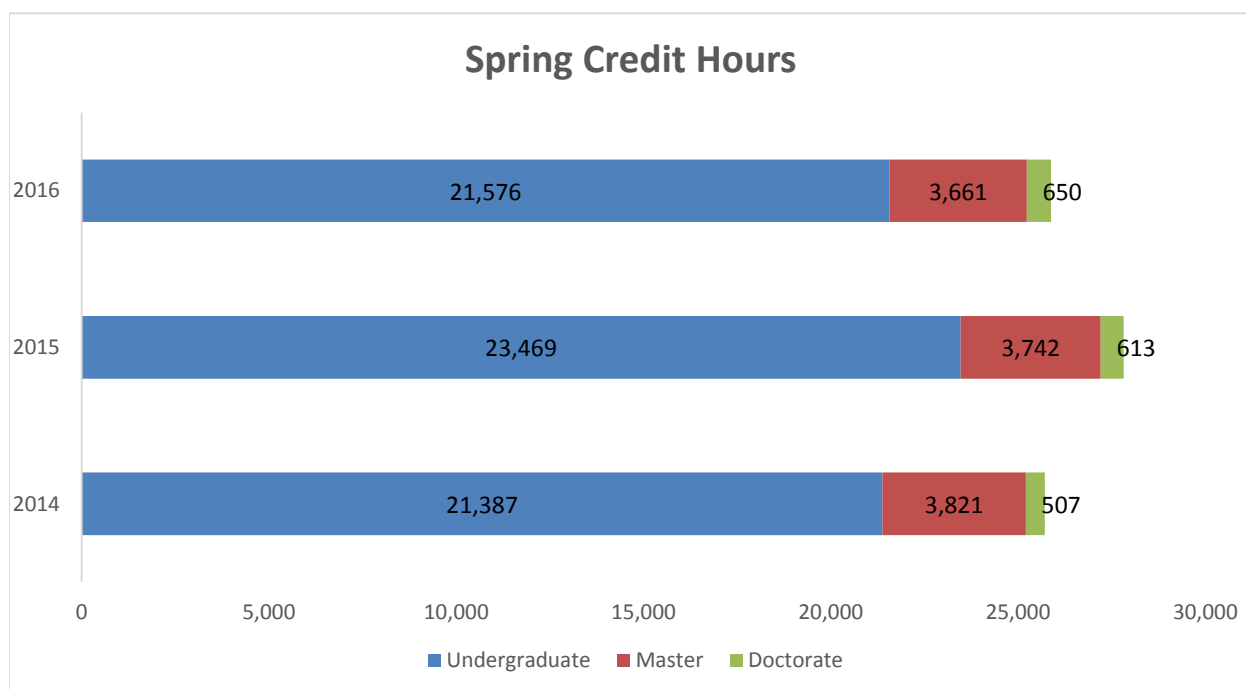
