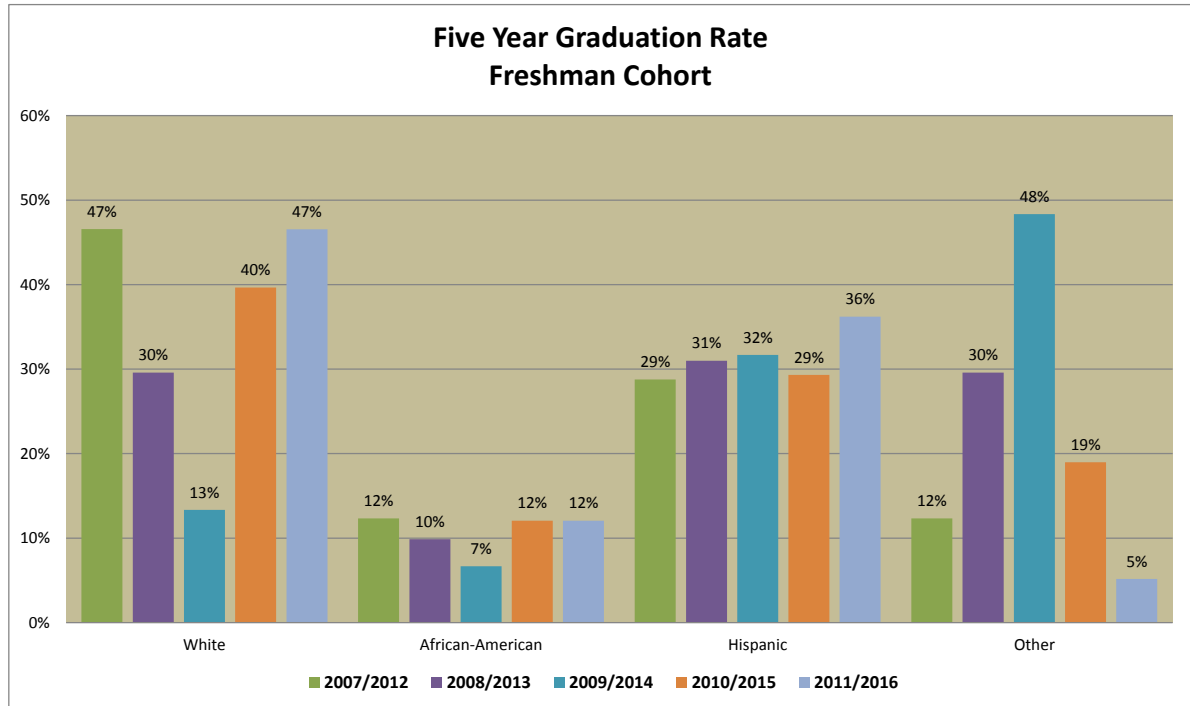
Freshman Cohort Four-year Graduation Rates Chart. Full Time Degree-seeking Undergraduates by Ethnicity

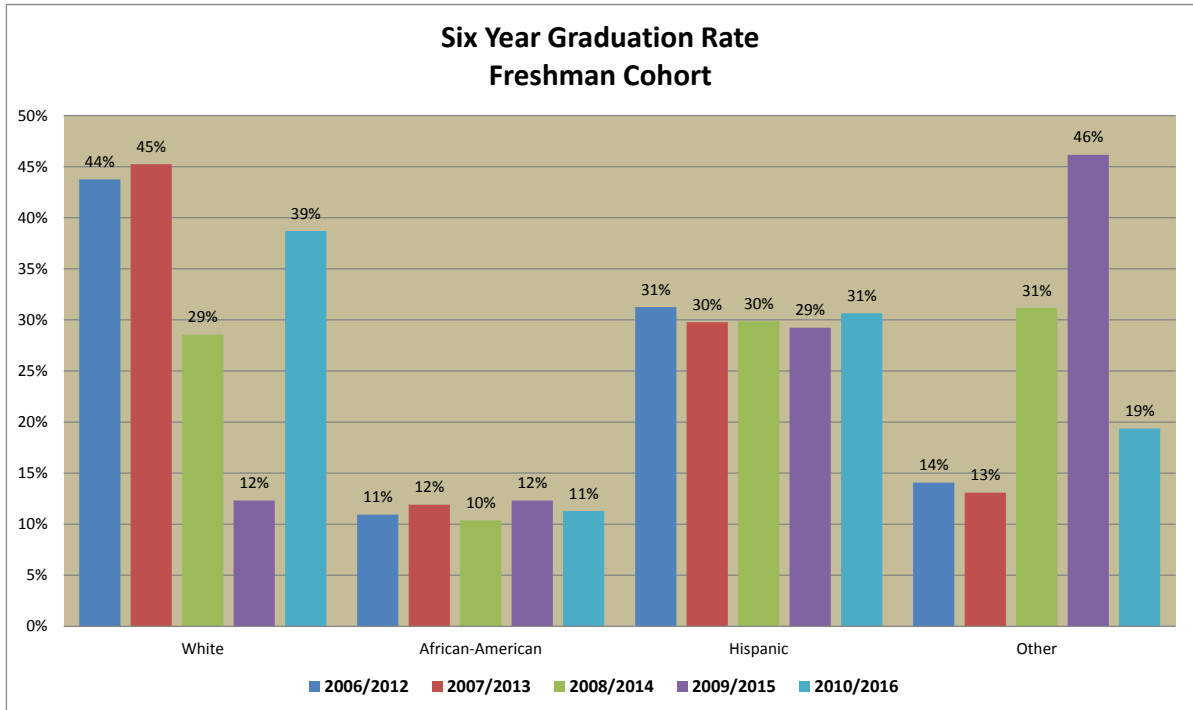

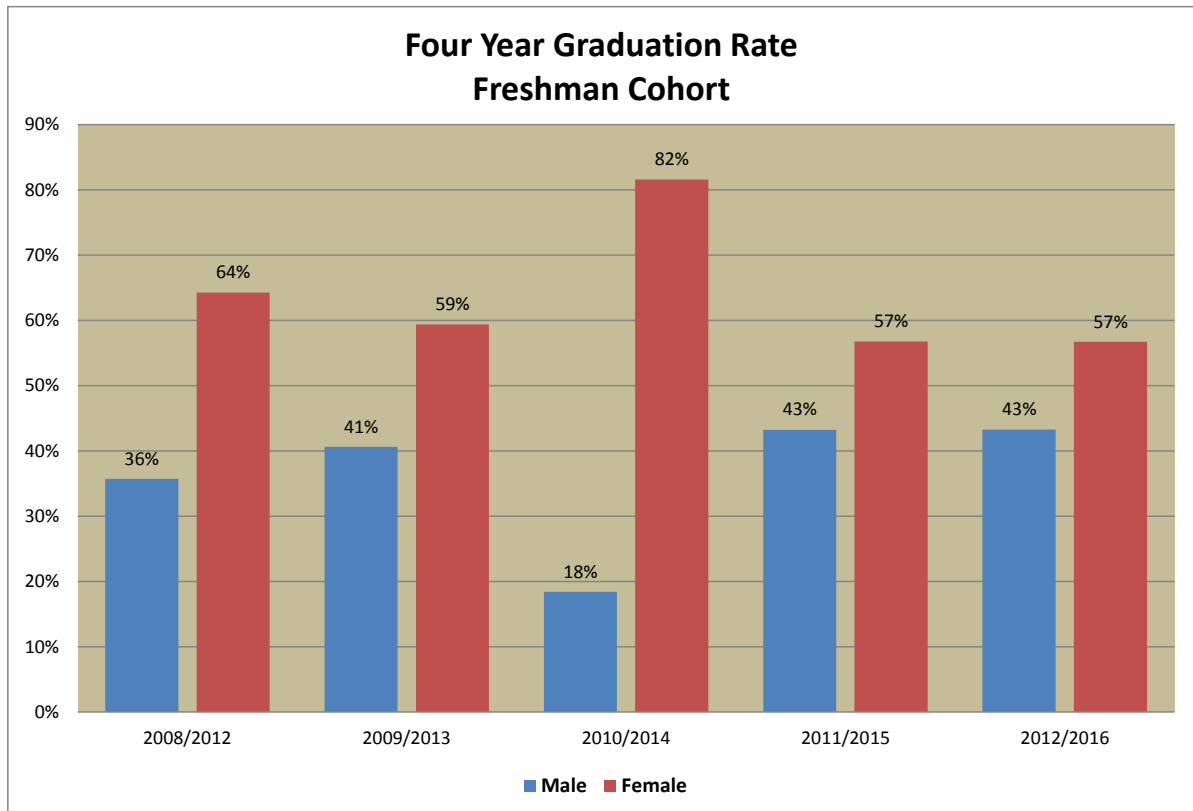

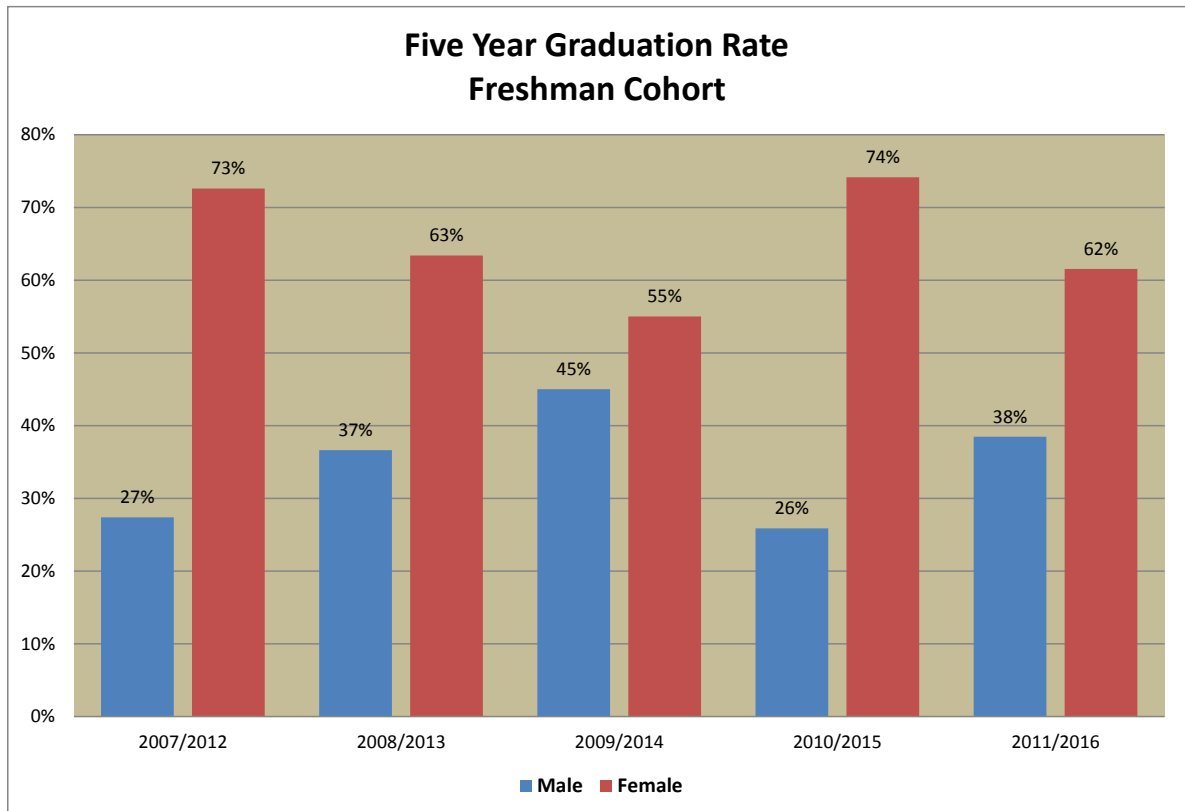
Freshman Cohort Four-year Graduation Rates Chart. Full Time Degree-seeking Undergraduates by Gender

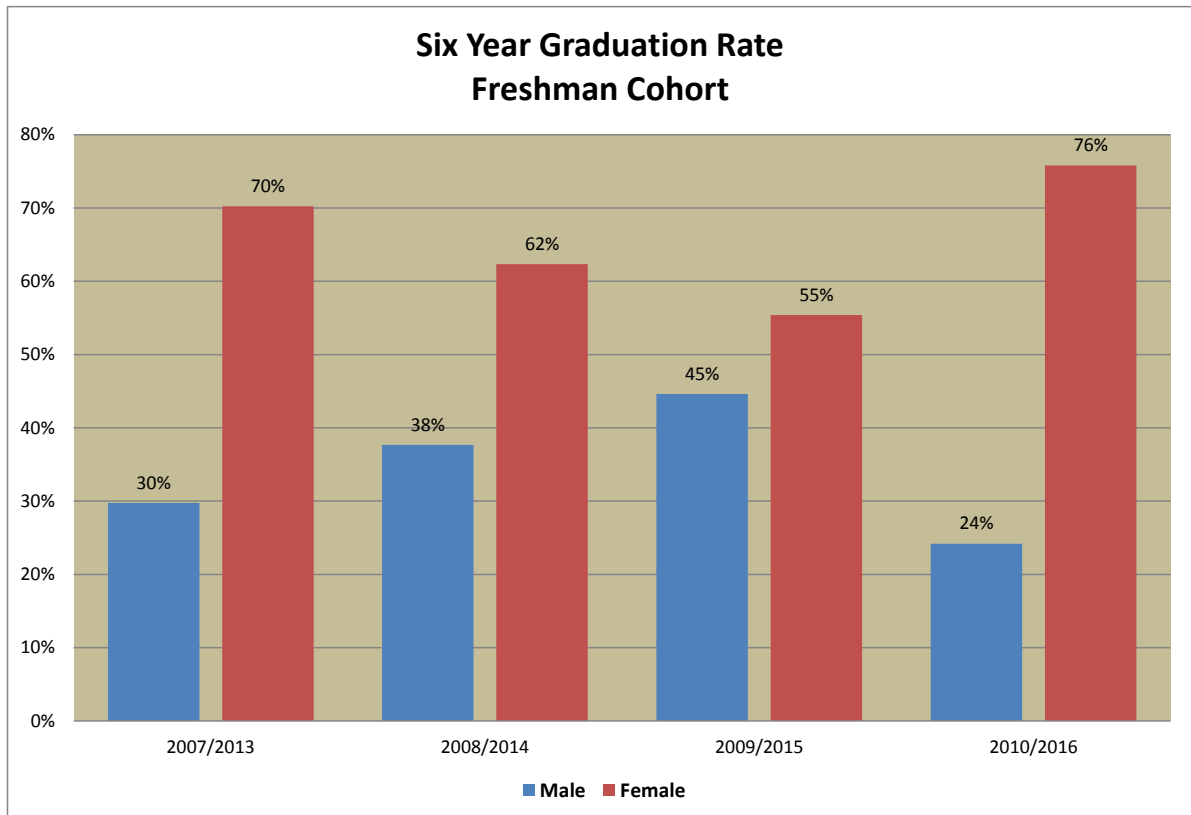
