



PREPARE FOR YOUR FIRST YEAR AS A DNAP STUDENT

Congrats on being admitted to the DNAP program! We've made getting ready for the program easier. Use this checklist to help prepare for your first year.

NOVEMBER

Make a plan to take a current chemistry course and/or college level algebra course if needed. Check the requirements at txwes.edu/dnapstudent.

Transcripts are due **June 15** for updated courses.

DECEMBER

- Apply for FAFSA

FEBRUARY

Complete credentialing paperwork ASAP – due **June 15** – including:

- Current passport photo
- Physician statement certifying your health
- Background check (\$100 fee)
- Malpractice form
- Financial responsibility

MARCH

- Complete credentialing to get registered

APRIL

Registration opens

- Complete credentialing to get registered
- Schedule an appointment with a financial aid counselor

MAY

- Finalize financial aid
- Sign up for a payment plan

JUNE

- Turn in required final chemistry and/or algebra transcripts by **June 15**

Find a place to live:

- Check out the apartment list/on-campus living & see what kind of lease works best for you at txwes.edu/dnapstudent
- Find a roommate, if needed

Get supplies:

- Purchase a laptop. Make sure to check system requirements at txwes.edu/dnapstudent
- Download Microsoft Office 365 and Firefox and Chrome web browsers for free by going to txwes.edu/dnapstudent
- Get a privacy screen for your laptop
- Purchase your textbooks. Be on the lookout for information from the department.

JULY

- RSVP for Partners in Anesthesia Student Success (PASS). Join us in August for a special session that provides resources for one program support partner (spouse, relative, friend, etc.). More details will be sent this month.

AUGUST

- Prepare for first day of class and orientation (3rd Monday)
- Get parking sticker from the library circulation desk (free)
- Student health Insurance available: txwes.edu/insurance
