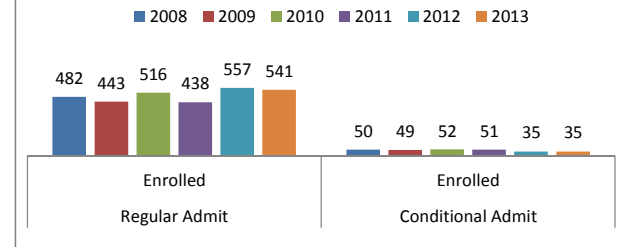

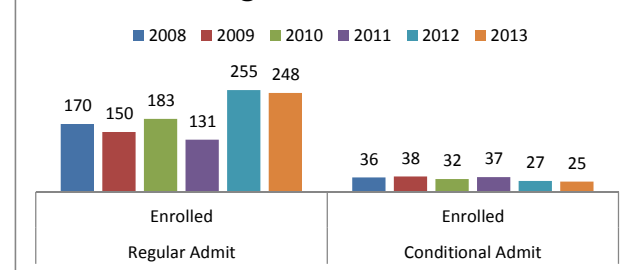
Acceptance Type of New Undergraduates Enrolled

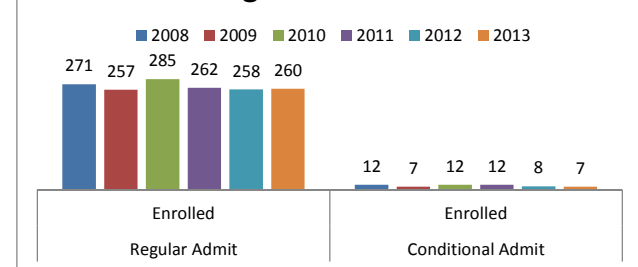
Acceptance Type of New Freshman Undergraduates Enrolled

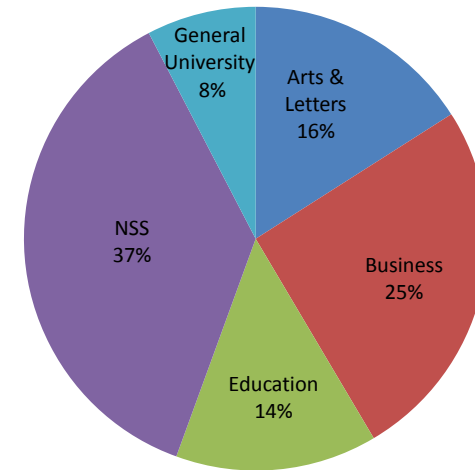

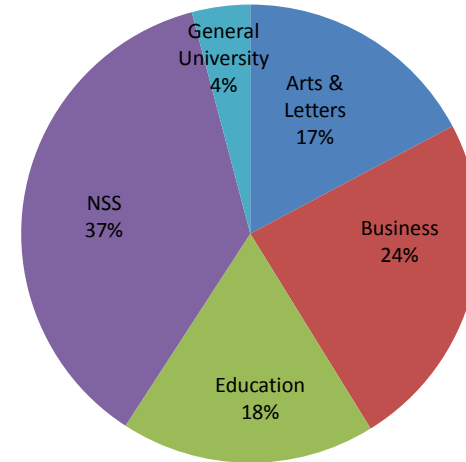

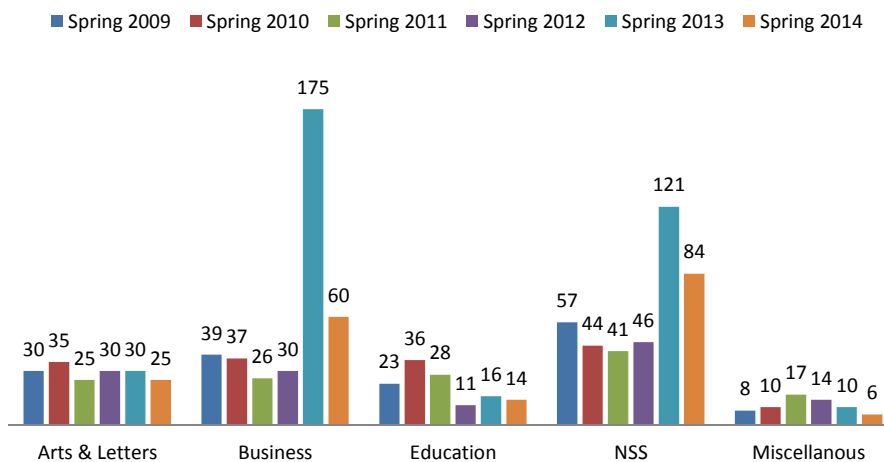

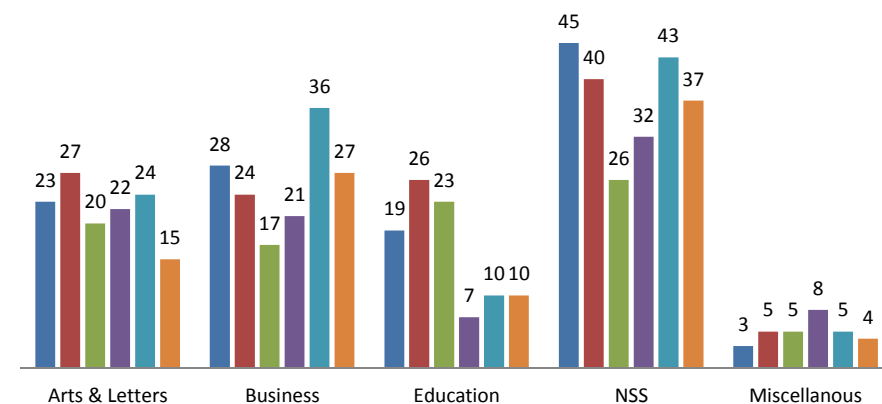
