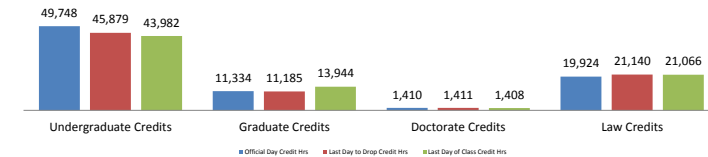
Academic Year 2014-2015



Academic Year 2013-2014



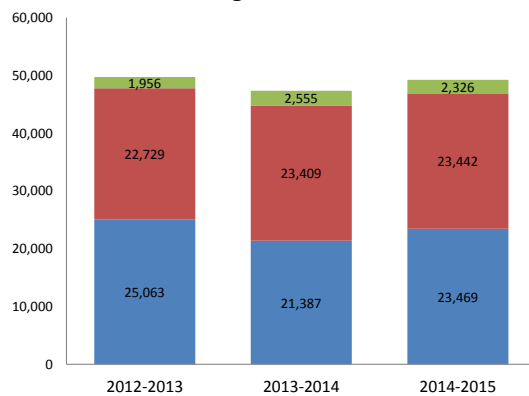

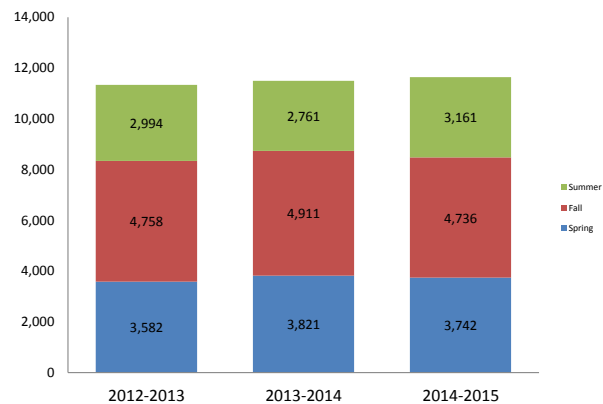

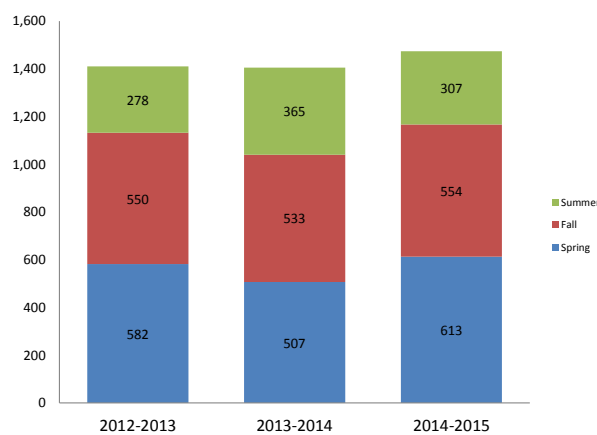
Undergraduate Credit Hours



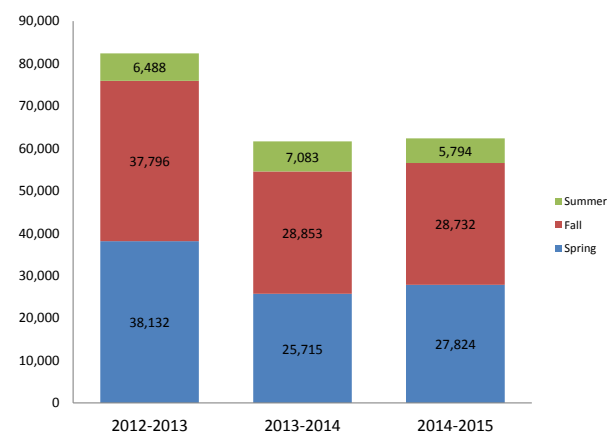
Graduate Credit Hours



Doctoral Credit Hours



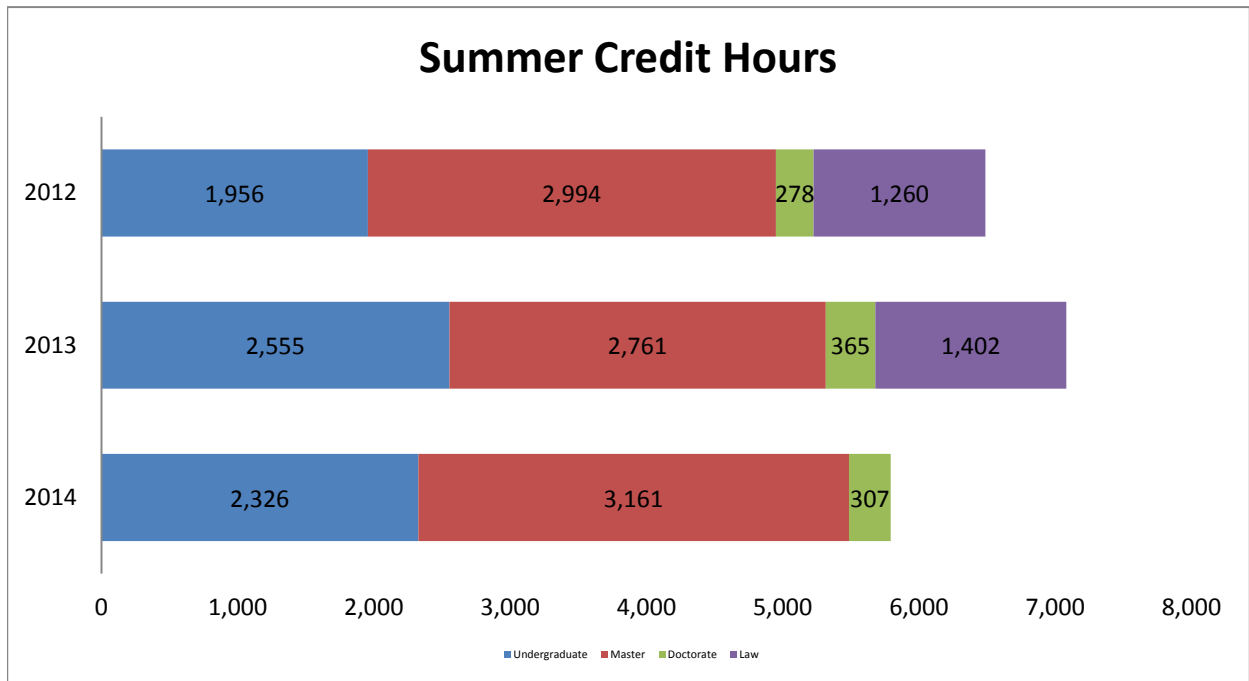

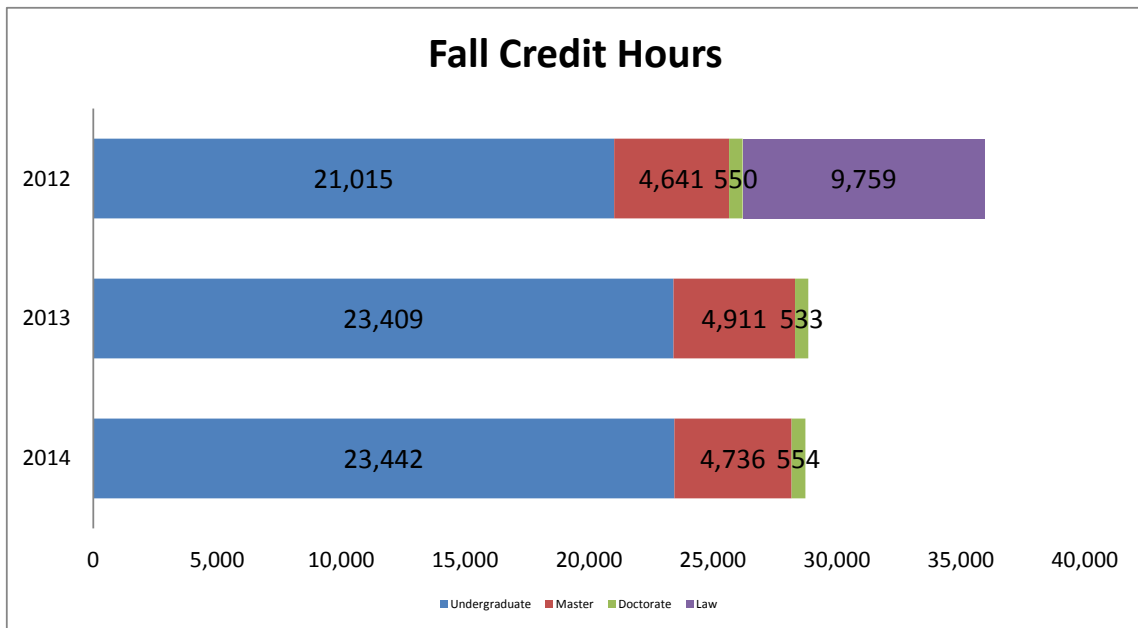

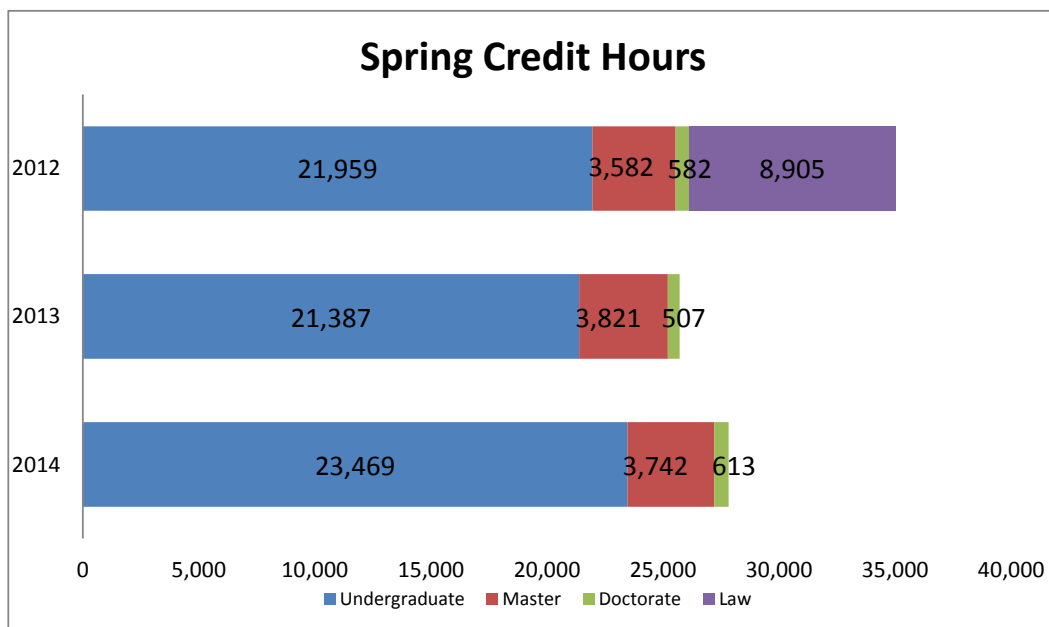
